With funding from the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation and collaboration with the University of Manitoba, Genesis Analytics has facilitated a 15-country learning network for HIV prevention since 2020. The 15 countries include Botswana, Côte d'Ivoire, Eswatini,

Ghana, Kenya, Malawi, Mozambique, Nigeria, the Republic of Congo, South Africa, South Sudan, Tanzania, Uganda, Zambia, and Zimbabwe. In line with our Integrated Learning Solution, we started with country assessments to identify strengths and weaknesses in each country's HIV prevention programme. We then conducted a cross-country analysis, matching countries based on their strengths and weaknesses. We then facilitated the development of learning agendas to enable countries to learn from each other and technical assistance plans to enable us to connect countries to assistance that cannot be found within the network. An external mid-term evaluation of the SSLN indicates better multisectoral alignment, improved knowledge, enhanced skills, and an increased demand for learning. The evaluation also recognised the SSLN as instrumental in informing prevention funding proposals and advocating for prevention in the region. To learn more about the SSLN click here.
